Post Office to Stay in Mountlake Terrace

MOUNTLAKE TERRACE—The Mountlake Terrace Post Office will stay in its current downtown location at 23210 57th Avenue West. The U.S. Postal Service announced that they recently signed a two-year lease agreement with the property owner, Calvary Fellowship Church. The Post Office has been in this location since 1967.

More than a year ago, rumors circulated that the Mountlake Terrace Post Office might be moved or closed due to the U.S. Postal Service downsizing for budgetary reasons.

“Residents will be very happy,” said Community Relations Director and City Clerk Virginia Olsen. “We have had many calls and emails from customers and residents throughout the area to support keeping the Post Office in Mountlake Terrace. In addition, our City Council has worked in partnership with Congressman Jay Inslee’s Office to communicate to the U.S. Postal Service the importance of retaining this facility here in our Town Center as it redevelops in the coming years.”
