City Awarded Electric Vehicle Stations

MOUNTLAKE TERRACE — The City of Mountlake Terrace has been awarded ten electric vehicle charging stations to be installed upon approval by Community Transit at the Transit Center, near I-5 and 236th Street SW.

The special charging stations are intended to help reduce greenhouse gases. They are valued at \$52,000 – part of a grant from ChargePoint America, funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and the Department of Energy.

The greater Seattle area is targeted for early release of an all-electric car, the Nissan Leaf. Another electric car, the Chevrolet Volt, is due for release this year, as well. Infrastructure for easy charging of these vehicles is important to making them a viable option for people.

As part of its adopted Sustainability Strategy, Mountlake Terrace is promoting environmentally-friendly transportation, including electric vehicles.
