Keep Your Pet Safe – Renew Their License

Mountlake Terrace Pet Licenses Expire on Dec. 31

MOUNTLAKE TERRACE — The City of Mountlake Terrace is reminding pet owners that annual licenses expire on December 31, 2011. All pet owners need to come to the Police Department, 5906 232nd Street SW, to get their new reusable license tags. A pet license is the best way to ensure the safe return of a lost pet.

All cats or dogs, three months old or older, must have and be wearing a current city tag to comply with city codes. Pets that are new to the city have up to 30 days for their owners to purchase their tags, which can be done at the Police Department. The tags are current for one year, and must be renewed every year thereafter. The licensing year matches the calendar year, so tags purchased now are current until December 2012.

Discounts apply for any spayed or neutered pets, as well as for all senior citizens 65 years or older with altered animals. The costs for pet licenses are \$30 for unaltered pets, \$15 for altered pets and a senior citizen rate of \$7.50 for altered pets only.
